

Fall Nominations Being Accepted for 2014 Land Conservation Awards

As part of the continued efforts and commitment of Land Development Services to recognize outstanding achievements in protecting the natural resources of Fairfax County, nominations are currently being solicited for the Fall judging of the **2014 Land Conservation Awards**. Any individual, firm, or organization who has observed superior land conservation efforts by a developer, designer, site superintendent, contractor or property owner, and believes that those efforts are worthy of recognition, may submit a nomination. The nomination deadline is **September 30, 2014**.

Representatives from the Northern Virginia Soil and Water Conservation District and the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality will begin the Fall judging on October 28, 2014, for consideration of additional nominated projects. Projects nominated and judged in the Spring will not be subjected to another field evaluation in the Fall. Overall winners will be selected from entries in both nomination periods, with overall winners announced at the January 2015 Land Conservation Awards ceremony.
