**Subject:** Fall Nominations Being Accepted for 2015 Land Conservation Awards

As part of the continued efforts and commitment of Land Development Services to recognize outstanding achievements in protecting the natural resources of Fairfax County, nominations are currently being solicited for the Fall judging of the **2015 Land Conservation Awards**. Any individual or organization who has observed superior land conservation efforts by a contractor, developer, engineer, engineering firm, property owner or site superintendent and believes that those efforts are worthy of recognition, may submit a nomination. The nomination deadline is **October 2, 2015**.

Representatives from the Northern Virginia Soil and Water Conservation District and the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality will begin the Fall judging October 13-15, 2015. Projects nominated and judged in the Spring will not be subjected to another field evaluation in the Fall. Overall winners will be selected from entries in both nomination periods, with overall winners announced at the January 2016 Land Conservation Awards ceremony.
