

Osbourn High School Doughnuts with the Trades

In a continued effort to promote careers in heavy construction in the high schools, HCCA is excited to partner with Osbourn High School's Career and Technical Education program. Not only does Osbourn HS offer a variety of construction-related courses, they also provide opportunities for local businesses to share their experience with the students of these courses.

The purpose of the "Doughnuts with the Trades" program is to promote trades education by giving high school STEM/CTE students time to speak with working professionals in small groups. Tradesmen will be asked to discuss the services their company provides, possible routes into the industry, and their professional/educational background. Osbourn HS recommends sending young company representatives as they will relate closer with the high school population.

Tradesmen will meet with students for doughnuts and coffee to discuss careers and work in the trades. Students will be in groups of five and will sit at a table with one tradesperson. Students will be provided with prompts and questions to facilitate the communication process. This program will be implemented with groups of 30 students and 6 or more tradesmen.
