OSHA COVID-19 Enforcement Update

OSHA COVID-19

The previous memorandum, [click here for details](#), has been rescinded, and this new "Updated Interim Enforcement Response Plan", [click here for details](#), is in effect until further notice. This guidance is intended to be time-limited to the current COVID-19 public health crisis.

This UPDATE is in relation to:

- Geographic areas where community spread of COVID-19 has significantly decreased.
- Geographic areas experiencing either sustained elevated community transmission or a resurgence in community transmission of COVID-19.

Keeping employees safe is a top priority of HCCA. We want to help Safety Professionals adhere to current safety measures and prepare for potential OSHA inspection. For these reasons, we would like to suggest the information published by OSHA, "**Prevent Worker Exposure to Coronavirus (COVID-19)**", both in [Spanish](#), and in [English](#), to be used as a "Toolbox-Topic", to hand out to your employees. To pass OSHA inspection, we strongly suggest that you keep proper documentation of safety meetings and training received by your employees, such as sign in sheets. Keep a safety file for each employee with this documentation so it is easily accessible.
